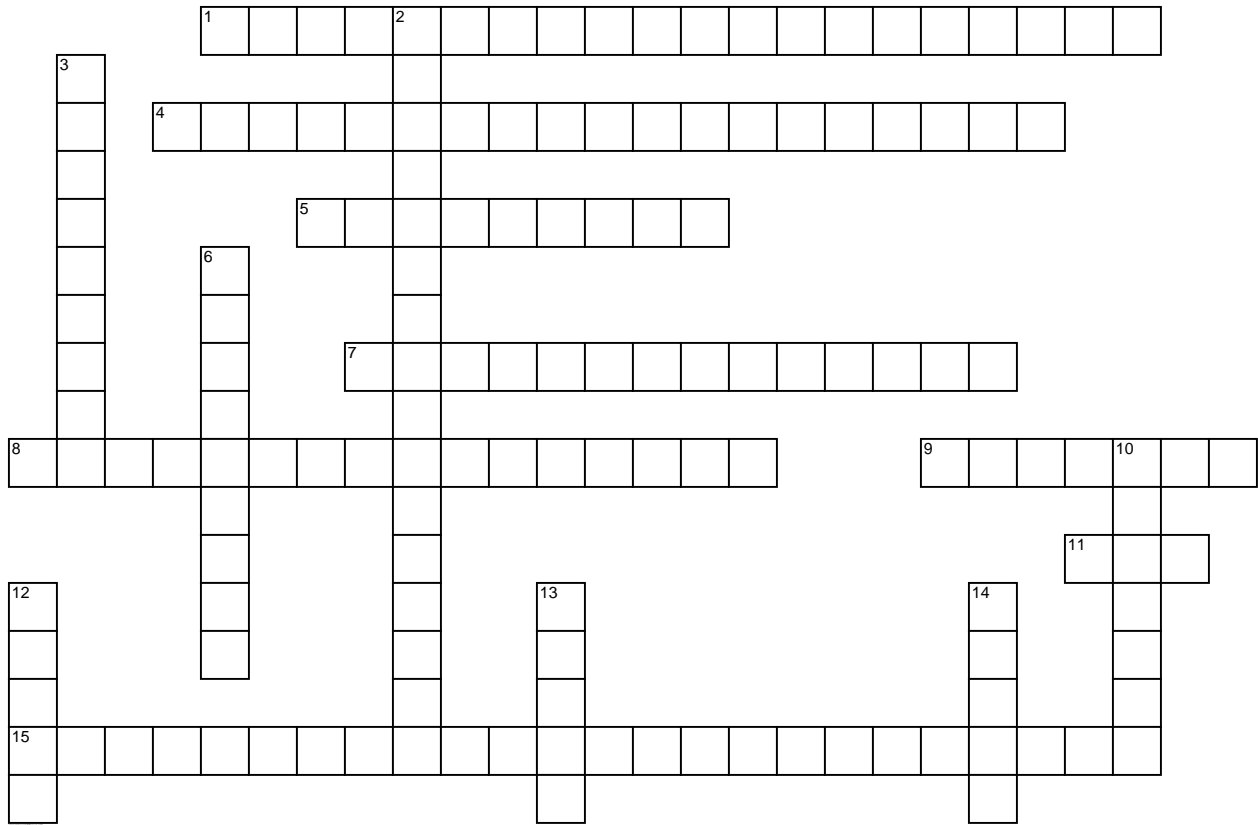


Ghosts of the Civil War

ACROSS

- 1 Tariff passed in 1828 which helped the North but hurt the South, and particularly angered states right advocate Calhoun
- 4 Loose connection of abolitionists who helped escaped slaves flee north
- 5 Slave who led an uprising that killed 55 white southerners
- 7 First and only president of the Confederacy
- 8 Grisly southern general who ironically was killed by one of his own soldiers
- 9 Lincoln successor and the first of only two impeached presidents in history
- 11 The most important man to the Confederacy
- 15 1863 doctrine that abolished slavery in the Confederacy.

DOWN

- 2 Law that required citizens of any state to assist in the capture and return of escaped slaves
- 3 Slave who petitioned for his freedom when his owner died because he had lived in territories where slavery was illegal
- 6 Allowed the army to forcefully collect the tariff garnered by the Compromise of 1833
- 10 Union general who led a notoriously destructive march through the South
- 12 Racist Supreme Court chief justice who ruled against Dred Scott
- 13 Important union general who led a successful offensive at Vicksburg
- 14 Lincoln assassinator
