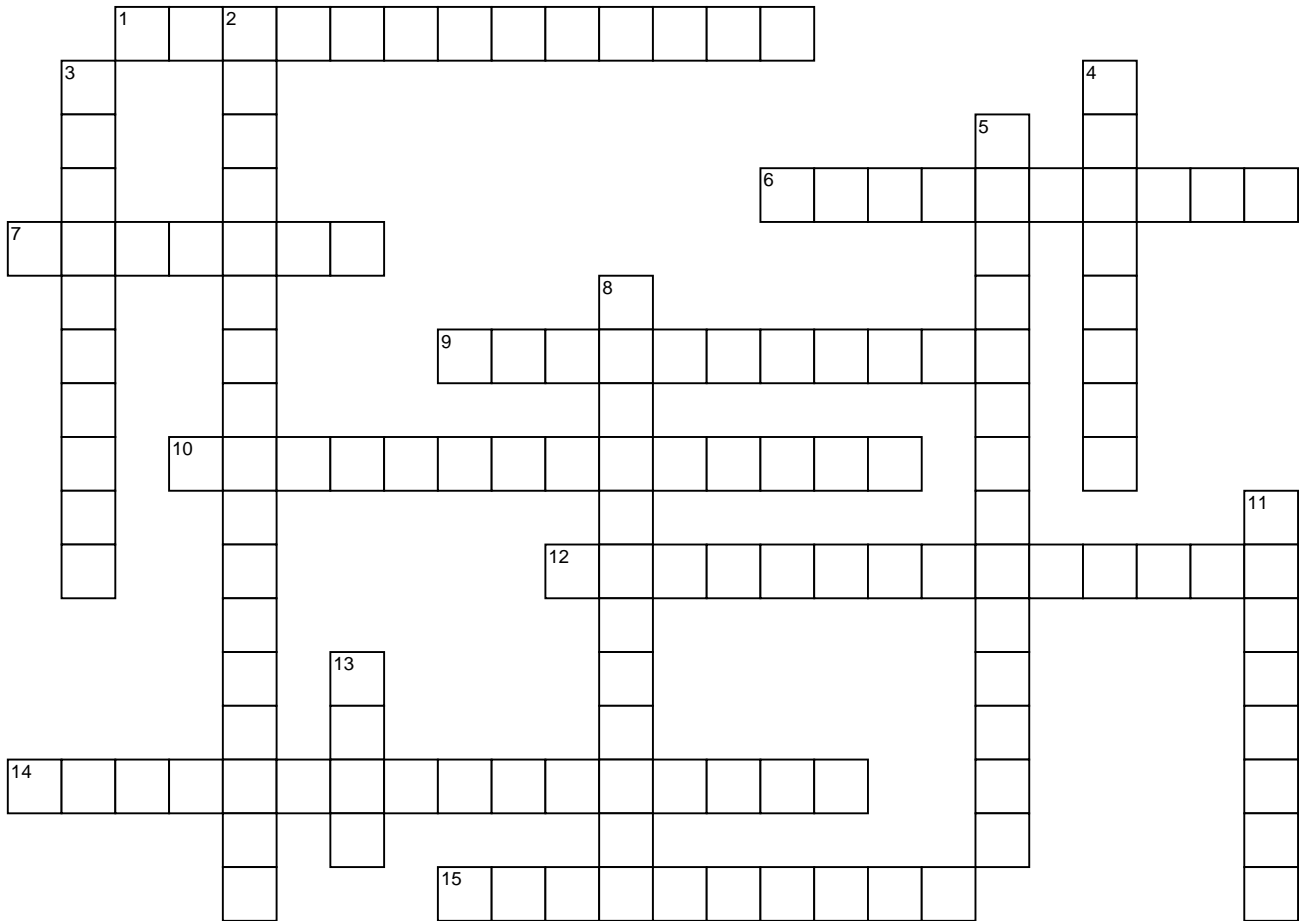

### ACROSS

- 1 A slave of Jefferson's with whom he had a lasting relationship and children
- 6 British frigate that fired on the American U.S.S. Chesapeake, boarded her and hanged four Americans
- 7 A tough, non-aristocratic president who achieved celebrity fighting Native Americans and the British in the War of 1812.
- 9 British practice of force American sailors to fight them, sparking the war of 1812
- 10 Conflicts between Britain and France that pulled America in by seizing its ships
- 12 Policy that stated America should dominate the Western Hemisphere, and Europe should stay out
- 14 Passed in 1830, this law gave the U.S. power to forcefully move Indians west
- 15 Tax that led to the whiskey rebellion

- 2 Business deal that more than doubled the size of America
- 3 Initiative that banned all ships departing from a U.S. port to a foreign port, ending all imports and exports to and from the colonies
- 4 Iconic ruler of France who sold Jefferson the Louisiana Territory
- 5 Indian tribe that attacked an Alabama fort massacring its inhabitants in response to white encroachment
- 8 Path the Cherokee were forced to walk from Georgia to Oklahoma between 1835-8, during which a quarter of the population died.
- 11 Famous Indian leader who tried to rally disparate tribes together against the American government
- 13 Vice President to Jefferson, and killer of Hamilton in a duel
