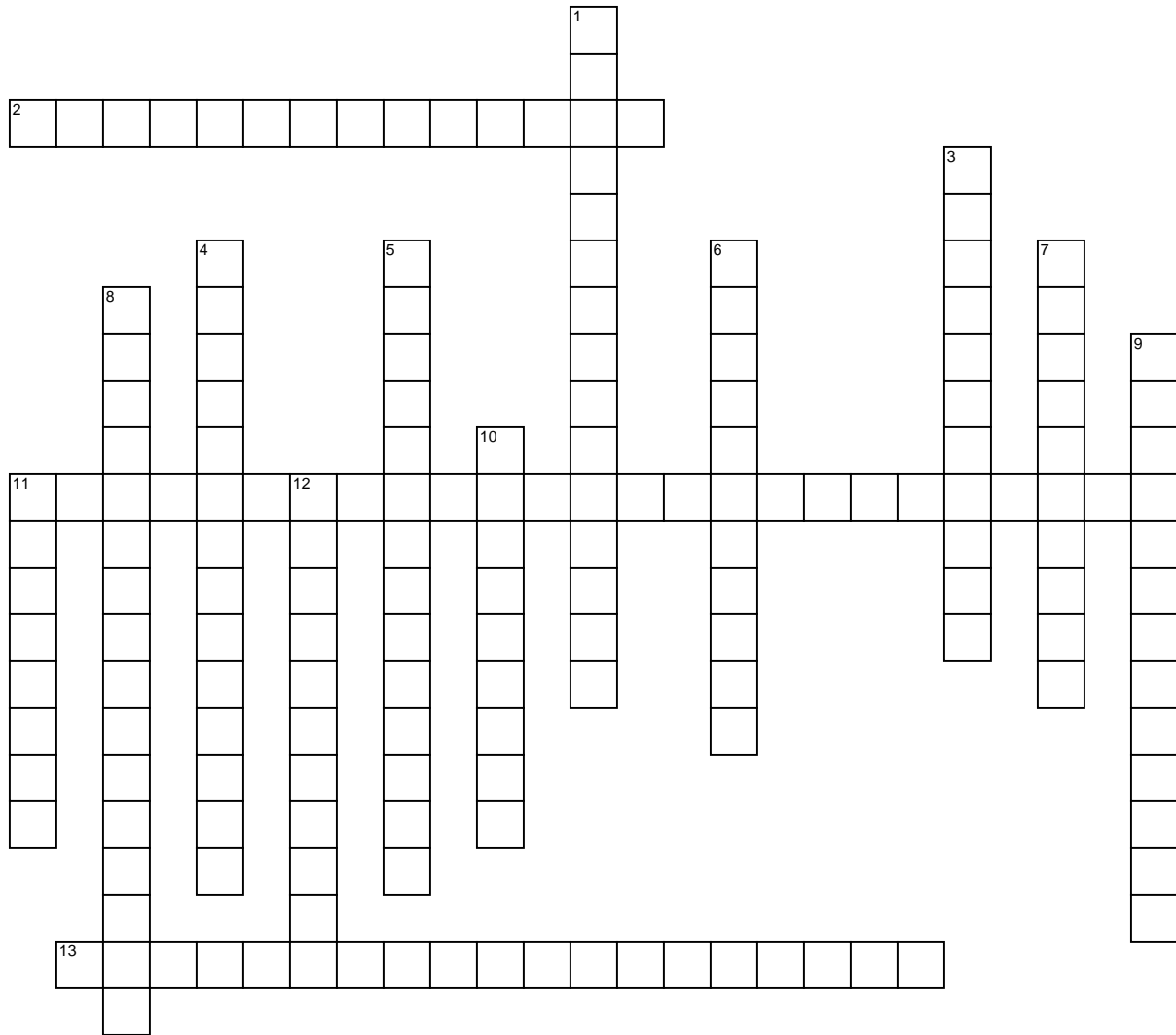

- 5 Famous event where \$70,000 worth of tea was destroyed in protest to the British monopoly on the trade
- 6 Revolutionary ring leader and prominent signer of the Declaration of Independence
- 7 Silversmith and horse-rider responsible for alerting the townspeople of the approaching British
- 8 War in which the French and a confederacy of Indians fought against Britain and her colonies
- 9 Radical colonial political group headed by Samuel Adams
- 10 Informal group of farmers ready to fight at a moment's notice
- 11 Colonial revolutionary and American icon
- 12 Thomas Paine's passionate pamphlet urging for independence from Britain
